II. Registration

Families wishing to be enrolled in Faith Formation **must** be registered members at The Church of St. Benedict or one of the other parishes within our Area Catholic Community (Seven Dolors, St. Anthony, or St. Martin). If families are not a member of these four parishes, admittance may still be accepted upon meeting with the Faith Formation Staff (please see **Tuition** section of this handbook). It is expected that all students wishing to be a part of the Faith Formation program be formally registered. All students must have current emergency contact and allergy information on file. Those not formally registered will not be allowed to join a class.

If you are unable to register online, please come to the Faith Formation Office (door #6).

III. Tuition

No student will ever be denied into the Faith Formation program for any financial reason (please see **COVID** section of this handbook). Tuition is to be paid online upon submitting the official registration form or by writing a check. Please note that students will **not** be enrolled unless payment has been received or arrangements have been made with the Faith Formation Office.

IV. Program Requirements

2nd grade students who desire to receive the sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist, must complete grade level 1 of Faith Formation **prior** to entering Sacramental preparation. Families new to the parish or program are to arrange a meeting with the Director of Faith Formation. Parents will be **required** to attend the parent meeting in January and work with their students in preparing for the Sacrament at home. First Reconciliation will be in the season of Lent and First Communion will be the last Sunday in April (please see *Calendar* section of this handbook).

Students in **Grades 6-10** must be enrolled in the Faith Formation program prior to entering the Confirmation program in grade 11. Students in grades 6-10 must also complete **one** of the following options:

Option 1: Two weekend retreats

- Grades 6-8: Dunrovin
- Grades 9-12: Castaway and/or Dunrovin and/or Sr. High Conference (Diocese)
- Grade 10: CM TEC

Option 2: One weeklong mission trip

- Grades 6-8: Duluth, MN (YouthWorks)
- Grades 9-12: Minneapolis, MN (A Call to Service – St. Cloud Diocese)
- Grades 9-12: Trip Location Varies (YouthWorks)

Option 3: Harvest of Hope Service Retreat

- Grades 6-12: Local Experience TBA

Option 4: 70 hours of local service + a parish presentation regarding Catholic Social Teaching (10 hours of each theme)

- Solidarity – Join forces with minorities and host sessions to get to know community members, Feed My Starving Children
- Life and Dignity of the Human Person – pray at Planned Parenthood, Gather items for Birthline
- Option for the Poor and Vulnerable – Serve at Catholic Charities or the food shelf
- Call to Family – Spend time with family (play games, eat meals together)
- Community Participation – Visit the nursing homes, volunteer at the parish
- Rights and Responsibilities – Partake in the Mission Office at the Diocese or local politics
- Care for God’s Creation – Clean up the cemetery or parks

Option 5 (Grade 10 ONLY): 30 Hours of Service Hours

For dates and more information, please contact the Faith Formation Office. These program requirements were set in place with the approval of the Faith Formation Committee, Staff and Pastor since 2015. The events listed are above and beyond the price of our Faith Formation tuition, financial assistance and fundraising may be available by contacting the Faith Formation Office. Please note that refunds will **not** be available for these events as these events require advance payment. Thank you for your understanding.

Confirmation Candidates (Grade 11) who desire to receive the sacrament of Confirmation, must complete grade levels 1-10 of Faith Formation **prior** to entering Sacramental preparation **along with** meeting St. Benedict's Faith Formation requirements.

Students (Candidates) enrolled in Confirmation **must** attend a day long retreat as required by the Diocese in addition to our requirements. Students unable to participate in any of the available Confirmation retreats being offered are to 'make-up' the retreat by attending a **weekend** TEC or Dunrovin. Any cost for the make-up retreat is the responsibility of the student/family (Castaway does not count as a Confirmation retreat). Candidates are also expected to participate in all areas of parish life and provide works of service as assigned by the Faith Formation Director and or Faith Formation Committee (please see **COVID** sections of this handbook).

Homework is a part of our Confirmation curriculum to ensure an understanding of the Sacrament and commitment to a life-long faith. Students will need to complete any assignments and pick a Confirmation sponsor in a timely manner.

V. Classes and Class Times

Due to the Coronavirus Pandemic, class times will look a little different. Classes in-person will rotate on an every other week schedule. Pre-school through Grade 5 will meet one Wednesday from 6:30 – 7:35 PM and then the next week Grade 6 – 11 will meet from 6:30 – 7:35 PM with Youth Group to follow (please see **COVID** section of this handbook). If conditions improve, we hope to offer weekly in person classes for Pre-school through Grade 11. On the weeks where students don't meet in person, virtual learning will be available via Google Classroom on our website.

There will **not** be Large Group while we meet every other week. If we were to return to normal weekly classes, Large Groups would look as follows:

- Grades 1 & 2 will meet in the Youth Room at 6:30 PM for 15 minutes.
- Grades 3-5 will head to their respective classrooms at 6:30 PM.
- Grades 6-11 will head to their respective classrooms from 6:30 – 7:15 PM and then meet in the Church for 15 minutes.
- Grades Pre-School and Kindergarten will meet in the respective classrooms from 6:30 – 7:20 PM. We ask that parents with Pre-schoolers or Kindergartens provide the snack which will be provided at 7:20 PM in the Kindergarten Room. There will be a sign-up rotation on the first or second night of class.

Students who arrive early must be supervised by a parent until large group time or be in the supervised Gym (6:00 – 6:25 PM). Assigned Gym supervisors will be scheduled on a rotation basis (please see *Volunteering* section of this handbook).

VI. Youth Ministry

Our Faith Formation program is heavily influenced by a Youth Ministry approach. Meaning, we believe in building relationships before teaching any content (curriculum). We also believe that each one of us is called to Youth Ministry and to lead our young Church to take action and own their faith. Our students are not the Church of the past or future, but the Church of today and that is why we focus on enabling students with the tools to be leaders and how to have a personal relationship with Christ.

Every other Wednesday, on nights where Grades 6 – 11 meet, we will offer Youth Group (Divided) following class from 7:35 – 9:00 PM for grades 6 – 12. Anyone and everyone of any faith is welcome to join us for videos, discussions, games, community building, homework help, or to have a safe place to come and be who they really are. Plan on joining us!

We will also pay special close attention to our 6th grade students. Studies show that 6th grade is the average age for students to disaffiliate from the faith. We don't want to lose these students who are on the margins, so to combat the negativity and statistics on disaffiliation we will offer 6th Grade Youth Group once a month during class time. Attendance will still be taken but we hope to make a relaxed atmosphere where talking about our faith is normal and casual during this time.

VII. Attendance

In Order for our program to provide the best Faith Formation experience for our students, consistent attendance is mandatory and expected. Attendance will be taken each time there is a scheduled class, event, or Mass. Please make every effort to be on time. In the event of an absence due to illness or family emergency, please contact the Faith Formation Office so that your student will be excused. Do **not** contact the catechist. Students will be denied to move forward if not in attendance at 80% of the time with or without warning (please see *COVID* section of this handbook).

Students in **Pre-school through 2nd grade** will need to be accompanied to their classrooms by a parent or guardian to sign-in. Students in **1st or 2nd grade** will need to be signed out of their regular classrooms and students in **Pre-K** will need to be signed out of the Kindergarten Room (please see *Classes and Class Times* along with the *Map* section of this handbook).

VIII. Behavioral Expectations

Everyone is expected to treat each other with respect and welcome others as we are all made in the image of Christ (Genesis 1:27). Anyone who disrupts class, harms another, or disrespects a person or Church property may be sent to the Faith Formation Office or be asked to be picked up and or be released from our program. Catechists are not responsible for poor behavior in class. Any issues regarding behavior **must** come through the Faith Formation Office. In the event that a student is to be released from the program, tuition is then forfeited and will not be refunded.

IX. Baptism

Please contact Toni Hudock to set-up your baptism. All parents will be required to go to a class if there is a desire to baptize. Classes are held at Seven Dolors on the second Saturday of every other month. Check the bulletin for upcoming sessions.

X. Sacraments

Any student who is in our program (especially those preparing for Sacraments) must be actively participating and receiving the Sacraments. Without attending Mass weekly or going to confession at least monthly – we miss an opportunity to know who Christ is. Students who frequently don't practice the faith or miss a lot of Faith Formation sessions may be asked to delay their reception of the Sacrament they are working towards (First Reconciliation, First Eucharist, Confirmation). It is the Sacraments which lead us to a life-long faith.

XI. Community Meal

The Community Meal will **not** be offered at the beginning of the year due to COVID-19. If we were to gather weekly in-person and receive permission from the Diocese of St. Cloud, the meal would resume and we would communicate that to you.

XII. Volunteering

It is our expectation that parents will volunteer to help with all aspects of the program. Without volunteers, our rigorous program would not be the same. As part of registration, we ask each family to sign-up for **two** volunteer roles such as the following; Catechists (Assistant Catechist)*, hall monitors, health supervisor, gym supervisor, youth ministry volunteer. All volunteers will be entered into Ministry Scheduler Pro (MSP) and scheduled using the automated scheduler. You can access the schedule online by clicking the Faith Formation tab. If you are unable to be present on your scheduled

night, it will be your responsibility to request a sub. In the event you need assistance locating your account credentials, please contact the Faith Formation Office. Due to COVID-19, we will **not** charge parents who choose not to volunteer (please see **COVID** section of this handbook). If there is a pastoral reason as to why you are unable to volunteer, please make special arrangements with the Faith Formation Office.

*Those who choose to be a Catechist or Assistant Catechist in our program will have their tuition fully waived and will not be required to volunteer in other capacities.

XIII. Adult Opportunities

There will be informal Basketball for young adult/adult men and women of any skill level in the gym during most classes. Young adults and adults are expected to sign a liability waiver prior to joining (please see **COVID** section of this handbook).

Young adult and adult opportunities will be listed in the bulletin and on the website along with email updates and or reminders.

XIV. Communication

We will communicate regularly through email but not limited to our website, Facebook, myParish App, bulletin, calls and or texts. Please make every effort to update us with your current email address and phone numbers upon registering for Faith Formation. Information such as this handbook/policies, calendars and volunteer information will be distributed on the opening night of Faith Formation along with being available on our website: www.hohcatholic.org/sbff

In the event of inclement weather or other unforeseen reasons (determined by the Faith Formation Staff), cancellations will be emailed, posted on our website, myParish App, and Facebook page.

XV. Fundraising

It is our expectation that all families help in our fundraising efforts. The Faith Formation / Youth Ministry budget relies heavily upon a minimum of \$10,000 of fundraised income. Fundraisers include but are not limited to the following; Albany Car Show, Caramel Rolls, Heggie's Pizza Sales, Butter Braids, and the Fish Fry. Our students would not be able to have the experiences they have without great fundraising efforts. A good year of fundraising can also allow us to keep tuition stable or even lower it. Thank you for your efforts in advance.

XVI. Parking Lot

In the interest of safety for our students, parents and staff there is a speed limit of 10 mph. Student drop off and pick up will take place at door #8. Please follow the arrows and route established and honor the STOP sign. Parking will be available in the lot and or street. Do not park in front of doorways or in traffic lanes. The alley between the Church and Parish Center will be blocked off between 4:45 and 11:00 PM for the safety of those traveling between buildings.

XVII. COVID-19 Safety Measures & Plans

COVID-19 has turned our world and our lives upside down. While schools and programs think of innovative ways to keep staff, students, teachers, and volunteers safe, we will continuously find ways to adapt to ensure a positive and safe learning environment for all participants. Please note that the Church of St. Benedict is **not** liable if a positive case, serious illness or even death occurs from contracting the virus while on our campus. Please review the bullet points to see what we have in place for the 2020 – 2021 Faith Formation Year:

- **Entrance / Dismissal**
 - Entrance will take place from Door #7 and Door #8 (drop-off).
 - Dismissal will take place from Doors #4, #5, #7, #8.
 - Hand Sanitizer will be available at each entrance / exit point.
- **Masks**
 - Masks will be required upon entry.
 - Masks are to be worn in classroom by students.
 - If there is an under-lying health condition or disability which would prohibit one to wear a mask, please submit a written letter from a medical professional to the Faith Formation Director.
- **Facility**
 - Drinking Fountains will ***not*** be available for use.
 - Signage will be posted to promote COVID-19 prevention, hand-washing, masking, social distancing, and symptoms of COVID-19.
 - Congregating in hallways or areas where social distancing isn't possible is prohibited.
 - Building and classrooms will be deep cleaned and sanitized prior to students coming for class.
 - Social distancing will be expected while on our campus.
 - Larger classrooms and spaces will be the only rooms used for Faith Formation to ensure social distancing.
- **Classes and Class Times**
 - Classes (grade levels) will meet in person every other week from 6:30 – 7:35 PM.
 - Virtual lessons will be available on our website on weeks certain grades don't meet for in-person class.

- **Tuition**
 - Realizing the financial impact of COVID-19, we want to ensure all families have the opportunity to register for Faith Formation. **No family will be denied registration for financial reasons.**
 - To help relieve our families who have lost their job or have been furloughed due to COVID, we would like to invite you to sponsor a family. To sponsor a family, please contact the Faith Formation Office.
- **Program Requirements**
 - Program Requirements are drastically shifting due to COVID-19. Several of our program requirements may not be available next year – we encourage families to think about options 3-5 to *prior* to entering Confirmation.
- **Attendance**
 - Attendance policies will continue to be reviewed, adjusted, and clearly communicated with families.
 - All symptoms / illness will be excused.
- **Volunteering**
 - We will not charge parents to opt out of volunteering due to COVID-19.
 - Volunteers will be necessary to help instill safe practices and assist with new procedures.
 - Volunteers must be flexible and adaptive to changing conditions and regulations from the Diocese and public health officials.
- **Adult Opportunities**
 - Adult basketball will still take place. A new waiver must be signed acknowledging that the Church is not responsible for any positive COVID cases.
 - Masking is recommended.
- **Health Checks (Positive Case)**
 - Staff, parents, students, volunteers are to self-report exposure, symptoms, and or positive test results to the Faith Formation Office within 14 days.
 - In the event of exposure or positive test, Faith Formation will may be cancelled for up to two weeks **unless** parish staff tests negative.
 - It is our expectation that individuals exposed will schedule a test and self-quarantine for 14 days unless the test comes back negative.
 - In the event of cancellation, curriculum will be available on our website for distance learning.
 - If conditions in our State, Church or community were to worsen, we may need to temporarily close our campus. During this closure we would focus on distanced learning and cleaning procedures for our facility.
- **Other**
 - The Community Meal has been postponed until further notice. If we receive permission to have the Community Meal, we will inform you via Email, our website and myParish App.
 - The bullet points above are adapted from the Dioceses of Crookston, Duluth, New Ulm, St. Cloud, and Winona-Rochester to re-open Catholic schools.

XVIII. Safe Environment and Background Check Compliance

The Diocese of St. Cloud, as well as other Catholic Diocese in the United States, have created a Safe Environment policy to protect our youth and all members of our Catholic Community. All adults who have the opportunity and privilege to come into contact with minors or vulnerable adults in any capacity must review the Diocesan Safe Environment policy each year. Background checks will be done on all adults who work with minors. At this time, background checks must be done every five years. Each year, the youth and adults are educated on maintaining a safe environment in our parish. This training includes information on whom to contact with concerns, and how to report those concerns. Parents need to annually review these policies and complete the training. **All adults and parents MUST complete Safe Environment training and a background check by creating an account.** Please see which situation applies to you below:

SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAINING FOR NEW USERS

If you are new, or have a background check that has expired this year or before:

1. Go to stcloud.cmgconnect.org and fill out the information under *Register for a New Account* and complete the information requested.
2. Do the **Safe Environment Training (St. Cloud)**. It should take about 1.5 hours. You can not skip over material, however, you may pause and come back to it.
3. Following training, this will prompt you to have your background checked. The cost of this falls on the parish, not you.

SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAINING FOR *RETURNING* USERS

If you have had your background checked within the last five years:

You should be good to go. If there is an issue, your background check is expiring or there is a need for you to complete some training, one of our Faith Formation staff members will reach out to you. Thank you for volunteering but more importantly, thank you for keeping our students safe.

XIX. Student and Parent Review of Policies

Parents, please read and review the policies with your students **prior** to submitting your registration. By formally registering in the St. Benedict's Faith Formation program, you are acknowledging that you have read, understand and will adhere to all the policies, requirements and commitments of our 2020 – 2021 program. The Pastor, Faith Formation Committee and Faith Formation Staff reserve the right to make changes to this handbook as necessary. Your submission will be viewed as a signed agreement. Thank you and we look forward to a wonderful year of programming. We are truly blessed to be on this journey of faith with your family.
